4. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

- a) For the post having GP ` 1800 – Pass in Matric or ITI or its equivalent.
- b) For the post having GP ` 1900 & 2000 – Pass in Matric with 50 % or higher education.
- c) For the post having GP ` 2400 (Technical) – Pass 10 + 2 stage in Higher Secondary in Science i.e. Maths or Physics or equivalent
- d) For the post having GP ` 2800 – A university Degree or its equivalent.

5. **AGE:** 18 - 25 years as on 01.01.2012. No age relaxation is permissible.

6. PERIOD OF RECKONING SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS:

The sports achievements of current & previous two financial years will be taken into account for eligibility. **Therefore, the sports achievements of on or after 01.04.2009 will only consider.**

7. HOW TO APPLY:

Application as per the format enclosed at annexure 'A' shall be submitted on A-4 size good quality paper. **The application format should be in English or Hindi language only and should be filled in English or Hindi only. The applications submitted in other than English or Hindi languages will be summarily rejected.** The application should be filled in by the candidate in his/her own handwriting and signed. The candidate has to affix one recent passport size photograph duly self attested on the application in the space provided for the purpose. Candidate is also advised to attach one extra passport size self attested photograph along with the application.

8. EXAMINATION FEE:

The candidates have to send a crossed Indian Postal Order or Bank Demand Draft drawn in favour of FA&CAO/NCR payable at Allahabad and as detailed below:

- a) For the post having GP ` 2400 – 2800 – ` 60.
- b) For the post having GP ` 1800, 1900 & 2000 – ` 40.

NOTE:

9. WHOM TO APPLY:

Application complete in all respects should be sent in a cover addressed to Assistant Personnel Officer/IR., North Central Railway, Headquarters office, Saraswati Block, Subedarganj, Allahabad -211033 so as to reach on or before last date. Application may also be dropped in the box kept in the CPO's Office, Saraswati Block, Headquarters office, Subedarganj, N.C. Railway, Allahabad on any working day (Monday to Friday) between 09.30 hrs to 18.00 hrs on or before last date.

NOTE: The applications should reach on or before 30.08.2011.

Candidates belonging to Andaman, Nicobar & Lakshadweep Islands closing date would be 14.09.2011, time upto 18.00 hrs. Such candidates should enclose a domicile certificate of Andaman, Nicobar & Lakshadweep Islands from and appropriate authority of the Andaman, Nicobar Administration or a certificate from a school or college last attended in Andaman, Nicobar & Lakshadweep certifying that the candidate has passed his/her examination from the school/college situated in Andaman, Nicobar & Lakshadweep

The recruitment will be based on trials with **DOPE TEST**, assessment of sports achievements and general intelligence/personality etc. The candidates **who are found fit** in trials only will be considered for next stage. An application/candidature may be rejected at any stage after found false and Railways take no responsibility to communicate the reasons whatsoever.

11. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- (a) Before applying to the post, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility norms as given in Para 3 above.
- (b) The name and initial of the candidate and father's name appearing in school/college certificates and in sports certificates should be one and the same. There should be no difference.
- (c) The specific position (Hammer throw/Javelin throw/20 Km walking/discuss throw/90 Kg/70 Kg etc.) played in the particular game/event if applicable should be mentioned in the application without fail.
- (d) The candidates already employed in Central/States/PSUs including Railways should submit their applications through proper channel duly submitting “no objection certificate” from their employer.
- (e) The decision of the Railway Administration in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the application, penalty for false information, and mode of selection shall be final and binding on the candidates.
